

Top Tips

- Networking in job search is about having conversations to gain insight and information.
- Know yourself; your strengths, weaknesses, concerns and what energises you. Use your strengths and have plans for the aspects you might find challenging.
- Try and reframe any negative thoughts and have a growth mindset.
- Remember that most people like to help when they know what they can help with.
- Networking is a key and validated part of your job search strategy.
- Start with warm contacts and build from there.
- Follow up on advice given and aways send note of thanks.
- Prepare and plan:
 - o What is your 'personal brand'? What makes you a potentially good employee?
 - o What are the parameters of what you are looking for or ideas you have?
 - What information or insight do I need?
 - Who is in my network?
 - Use a networking planner to be organised.
 - What are my goals for networking? (eg 2 meetings per week).
- Networking is relevant at every stage of your job search.

- What companies are leaders in the field?
- Which companies have a good reputation for [your interest]?
- Which companies seem to be growing?
- What do you know about the culture of the organisation/s?

Understanding targe roles

- What is the scope of the role?
- What would an ideal candidate in this role look like?
- What experience/qualifications are valued?
- What other roles might be an option?

Discovering opportunities

- How does the <u>organisation</u> source new staff?
- What is the general recruitment process used?
- What is the best way to explore if there is a current opportunity?
- Who else would you suggest I speak to who could help me?
